1 - 2	Rock forward on right. Rock back onto left.	Rock. Step.	On the spot
3 & 4	Shuffle step 1/2 turn right, stepping - Right, Left, Right.	Shuffle Turn	Turning right
5 - 6	Rock forward on left. Rock back on right.	Rock. Step.	On the spot
7 & 8	Shuffle step 1/2 turn left, stepping - Left, Right, Left.	Shuffle Turn	Turning left
Section 2	Right Grapevine with Touch, Left Rolling Grapevine with Touch.		
9 - 10	Step right to right side. Cross left behind right.	Step. Behind.	Right

25 - 26	Step forward right. Pivot 1/4 turn left.	Step. Turn.	Turning left
27 - 28	Step forward right. Pivot 1/4 turn left.	Step. Turn.	
29 - 30	Cross right over left. Step back left.	Cross. Back.	Back
31 - 32	Step right 1/4 turn right. Step left beside right.	Turn. Together.	Turning right
