4 WALL – 48 COUNTS – INTERMEDIATE

STEPS	ACTUAL FOOTWORK	CALLING SUGGESTION	DIRECTION
Section 1	Crossing Twinkle Steps With 1/2 Turn Right (x 2)		
1 – 3	Cross left over right. Step right to right side. Step left to left side.	Cross 2 3	Right
4 – 5	Cross right over left. Step left beside right making 1/4 turn right.	Cross Turn	Turning right
6	Make 1/4 turn right stepping right to right side.	Turn	
7 – 12	Repeat counts 1 – 6.		
Section 2	Cross Rock Side (x 3) Grapevine		
1 – 3	Cross rock left over right. Recover onto right. Step left to left side.	Cross Rock Side	On the spot
4 – 6	Cross rock right over left. Recover onto left. Step right to right side.	Cross Rock Side	
7 – 9	Cross rock left over right. Recover onto right. Step left to left side.	Cross Rock Side	
10 – 12	Cross right over left. Step left to left side. Cross right behind left.	Cross Side Behind	Left
Note	1 - 12: Often danced as twinkle steps, but originally choreographed as above.		
Section 3	Side Left, Slide, Side Right, Slide		
1 – 3	Step left large step to left side. Slowly slide right beside left.	Left 2 3	Left
4 – 6	Step right large step to right side. Slowly slide left beside right.	Right 2 3	Right
Section 4	Step Slow Kick & Back 1/2 Turn (x 2)		
1 – 2	Step left forward. Slowly kick right forward (with toe pointed).	Step Kick	Forward
3	Begin lowering right leg.	and	
4 – 5	Step right back. Turn 1/2 left stepping left forward.	Back Turn	Turning left
6	Step right beside left.	Together	On the spot
7 – 12	Repeat counts 1 - 6.		
Section 5	Twinkle 1/4 Turn, Basic Twinkle Back		
1	Step left diagonally forward making 1/4 turn left.	Turn	Turning left
2 – 3	Step right beside left. Step left in place.	2 3	
4 – 6	Step right back. Step left beside right. Step right in place.	Back 2 3	Back
